Parish Statement

We, in the Parish of Our Mother of Divine Grace value and encourage the participation of young people in parish liturgies and in activities that enhance their spiritual, physical, emotional and social development. We recognize the dignity and rights of all young people and are committed to their protection and support.

In keeping with this we will work to do all in our power to create safe environments for young people in order to secure their protection and enable their full participation in the life of the Church.

All personnel and volunteers have a duty to ensure the safety of the young person involved in parish activities. Reporting any concerns of a child protection nature is an obligation – it is not optional. Failure to report concerns can be seen as complicity.
